

22nd ANNUAL B.F. ADAM GOLF CLASSIC TO RETURN TO FAMED BLACKHORSE GOLF CLUB ON THURSDAY MAY 19TH

The B.F. Adam Golf Classic – one of the largest and most charitable non-celebrity tournaments in Houston, returns to the magnificent BlackHorse Golf Club on Thursday, May 19th. The tournament, named in honor of lifelong Cy-Fair resident and devoted school board member, B.F. (Bernard Fred) Adam, has raised over \$1.5 million since its inception in 1989. The 2010 tournament raised an impressive \$110,000 and this year’s organizers hope to bring in another \$100,000. All proceeds benefit student scholarships through the Cy-Fair Educational Foundation.

Third-year tournament Chair and CFEF Board Member, Jerry Ashmore (along with Co-Chair, Mike Bubela), is not only appreciative, but humbled by the area’s continued support, especially during difficult economic times.

“I believe the citizens and businesses in this community understand that higher education is more important than ever,” Ashmore said. “Providing scholarships to deserving Cy-Fair ISD students can only help to keep our community thriving for years to come. The tournament, a **4 Person Scramble**, will once again be held at the BlackHorse Golf Club (on Fry Rd. in Cypress). This stunning 36-hole course, designed by golf legends, PGA and Senior Tour professional, Peter Jacobsen, and renowned golf instructor, Jim Hardy, was uniquely crafted to provide a great experience for golfers of all levels and to offer an eclectic range of environmental changes throughout the course.

The Cy-Fair Educational Foundation celebrated 40 years of commitment to providing college education opportunities in 2010, and that dedication is as unwavering today as it was when the CFEF was founded. College costs continue to rise, creating financial difficulties for family’s at all socioeconomic levels. In today’s world, a college education is required for many, if not most, career opportunities, and the foundation’s scholarships are in great need.
