

NEW CY-FAIR EDUCATIONAL FOUNDATION PARTNERS PROGRAM OFFERS TRIPLE REWARDS AND HONORS FOR FOUNDATION

For the past 40 years the Cy-Fair Educational Foundation has raised more than \$4 million to fund student scholarships and teacher grant programs, and the Cy-Fair community is at the heart of that success.

In celebration of that strong support, the Foundation has introduced its new “Foundation Partners” program this year to recognize and honor the contributions of companies, organizations and individuals that participate in the Foundation’s three major annual fund-raisers: Salute to Our Heroes in February; the B.F. The steady support provides a strong and solid foundation for these vital events.”

CFEF’s inaugural Platinum Foundation Partner is Cypress Fairbanks Medical Center Hospital; and two Gold Foundation Partners are Caldwell Companies and Cy-Fair Federal Credit Union.

Terry Wheeler, Cypress Fairbanks Medical Center Hospital’s chief executive officer, said with seven years on CFEF’s board of directors he has come to fully appreciate the Foundation’s impact on the community.

“Becoming a Platinum Foundation Partner was a way to more strongly, and more formally, support CFEF,” Wheeler said. “This also allows us to make a commitment to doing a better job for the organization.”
